

Section D: Privacy Notice

The Transport Ticketing Authority (TTA) understands and respects your right to privacy and are committed to privacy protection. The *Information Privacy Act 2000* (Vic) and TTA's Privacy Policy regulate how we collect and handle your personal information.

The cardholder ('you') will generally be able to access your personal information. If personal information sought by the Transport Ticketing Authority (TTA) ('we' or 'us') is not provided, we may not be able to fulfil your request. Personal information provided by or about you or generated by using the Card is collected by the Public Transport Authorities# to issue and administer the Card and relevant entitlements.

Personal information held by the Public Transport Authorities# may be used or disclosed (including to each other) for the operation of myki; to verify entitlement to concession travel; for ticketing enforcement; complaint resolution; in emergencies; otherwise as required or authorised by or under law; or with your consent.

Section E: Terms and Conditions

1. Issued subject to the Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983, Regulations and Conditions of Use.
2. You must carry your VPT War Widow/War Veteran concession myki when travelling on a concession fare and present it on request.
3. The VPT War Widow/War Veteran concession myki remains the property of the issuing Public Transport Authority#. A lost, stolen, damaged or non-operational War Widow/War Veteran concession myki may only be replaced at the Metlink Central Pass Office.
4. Your VPT War Widow/War Veteran concession myki can only be used by you and is not transferable to others.

Section F: Eligibility Criteria

War Veteran Eligibility Criteria

The VPT War Widow/War Veteran concession myki is available to Victorian War Veterans:

- who have undertaken war/peacemaking/peacekeeping service overseas; **AND**
- are in possession of a Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) Gold or White Card or documented evidence of ongoing compensation or a lump sum payment from DVA for an injury/illness related to this service at the time of this application; **AND**
- **reside in Victoria.**

The applicant must supply either:

- a colour photocopy of their DVA Gold or White Card; or
- a photocopy of ongoing compensation or a lump sum payment for an injury/illness related to DVA service.

AND

The applicant must also supply documentary evidence of overseas war service from one of the following theatres of war:

- East Timor

War Widow/er Eligibility Criteria

The VPT War Widow/War Veteran concession myki is available to Victorian War Widows:

- who are in possession of a DVA Gold Card embossed War Widow (colour photocopy to be supplied); **AND**
- who are in possession of their partners documentary evidence of overseas war service from one of the above theatres of war (photocopy to be supplied); **AND**
- **reside in Victoria.**

Holders of the following concession cards are currently ineligible for a War Veteran or War Widow/er Concession Card.

- Victorian Seniors Card
- Australian Pensioner Concession Card
- Victorian Public Transport Free Pass
- Victorian Health Care Card
- Any other concession card valid for concession fares on public transport in Victoria
