Construction is complete on the tunnels and three of the five new underground train stations - Arden (in North Melbourne), Parkville and Anzac (on St Kilda Road).

We're building the Metro Tunnel

As part of Victoria's Big Build, we're building the Metro Tunnel which is the biggest upgrade of Melbourne's train network since the City Loop opened in 1981.

The Metro Tunnel will create a turn-up-and-go service for passengers on the Cranbourne, Pakenham and Sunbury lines.

As we test the tunnel's new systems and conduct trial operations in the leadup to opening in 2025, buses will replace trains at various times on sections of the Sunbury Line.

Metro Trains will also be completing maintenance works on the Sunbury Line.




